



TMA Lifelong Leadership Program | FAQs

Q1: What will I gain from completing the TMA Lifelong Leadership Program?

A1: Participants will grow their leadership skills in one of the three areas: organized medicine, practice leadership, or advocacy.

After completing the requirements for their selected concentration, participants earn a Lifelong Leadership Program Certificate, which is valid for five years.

TMA physician members will gain the skills and confidence to lead within organized medicine, their workplace, and their community.

Q2: What is the cost to participate in the Lifelong Leadership Program?

A2: The program is offered as a member benefit and is complimentary for TMA physician members.

Q3: Who is eligible to enroll in the TMA Lifelong Leadership Program?

A3: Participation is open to any TMA physician member who has completed their residency/fellowship, at any level of their career. Completion of TMA's Leadership College as a young physician in advance of enrolling in the Lifelong Leadership Program is highly encouraged but not required.

Q4: When can I enroll in the program?

A4: Enrollment is open year-round on a rolling basis.

Q5: How can I enroll in the program?

A5: Enrollment is simple – complete [this form](#) and select your program concentration of choice: Organized Medicine, Practice Leadership, or Advocacy.

Q6: What are the requirements of the program?

A6: The self-paced, 18-month program consists of a combination of in-person and on-demand courses and activities centered on **one** of the three concentrations: Organized Medicine, Practice Leadership, or Advocacy.

The curriculum consists of the following components:

- CME requirements: Complete at least **six** concentration-specific courses offered by TMA (combination of in-person and on-demand options).
- Attendance requirements: Attend a combination of at least **four** meetings and events.

Q7: How long will the program take?

A7: The program is self-paced, and each candidate will have 18 months from the date of enrollment to complete the requirements for their selected program concentration.

Q8: How can I show completion of the curriculum?

A8: Participants will self-report their completion of course requirements through a dedicated online portal. Documentation of or proof of attendance at in-person events not hosted by TMA will be required.
